Management Events Studio sustainability policy

At Management Events Studio (hereafter MES), we believe that we have an obligation — to our employees, our community, our investors, our customers and the environment — to operate our business sustainably. Our management carries the responsibility of committing our employees to comply with our environmental objectives and to implement this policy.

Action Statement:

Operating our business sustainably has always been an important value at MES and this commitment plays a significant role in our day-to-day business operations. These are the quiding principles we adhere to:

- Minimizing environmental impact and minimizing operational costs through thoughtful resource use, conservation, and waste reduction
- Driving profit responsibly
- Fostering a culture of involvement in sustainability through employee education and engagement, and
- Enabling our customers to become more sustainable by our event and exhibition know-how and best environmental practices.

MES commits to:

- Continue to develop events, trade fair booths and features designed to enhance and support the sustainability initiatives of both employees and our customers
- Partner with suppliers that operate sustainably, reduce waste, and commit to deliver more durable and recyclable materials, as well as reusable materials in our projects
- Continue to provide healthy workspaces for our employees through sustainable construction, operations, and certification whenever possible
- Drive towards fuller transparency from MES vendors
- Challenge old ways of doing in favor of more sustainable approaches
- Improve tracking of sustainability metrics throughout our operations and supply chain
- Strive to measure (business travel, supply chain, commuting, etc.) carbon emissions in our
 events and report them to our customers and employees in order to implement strategies to
 reduce them
- Develop the ability to measure and reduce all travel-related emissions by working with our suppliers, encouraging our employees to commit to public transportation and zero-carbon commuting, and to reduce employee travel overall
- Maintain solid waste diversion for our operations through a combination of waste reduction, composting, reusing and responsible recycling, for all sites and events, whenever possible

- Educate and engage employees on sustainability at home, work, and throughout their communities through a combination of employee communications, learning sessions, and hands-on opportunities
- Report results of our sustainability program to employees, partners and other stakeholders

Final statement:

MES employees, vendors and sub-contractors have a legal duty to ensure that all country-appropriate environmental laws and regulations are met. MES expects that each employee, vendor and visitor will follow the above practices to ensure that MES meets its sustainability goals.
